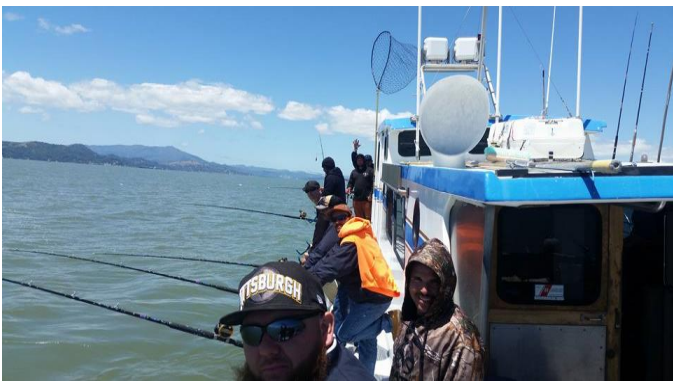
EMPLOYEE APPRECIATION: Pacific West's 1st ANNUAL Fishing Trip
